PAWNEE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Pawnee County Board of Commissioners met in regular session, which was open to the public, on Tuesday, November 30, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. in the first-floor meeting room in the Pawnee County Courthouse, Pawnee City, Nebraska. Notice of such meeting was published in the Thursday, October 21, 2021, issue of the Pawnee Republican. Present were Ron Seitz, Jan Lang, Lavon Heidemann and County Clerk, Candi Nicholas. Chairman Seitz opened the meeting and announced the open meeting law poster is posted on the east wall of the meeting room. Ashley Laflin, Director of Four County Diversion, met with the Board and discussed the Crime Commission Grant for Juvenile Diversion. Lang moved and Heidemann seconded to approve the Memorandum of Understanding for the Nebraska Crime Commission 2023 Community-based Juvenile Services Aid Application. Candi Nicholas met with the Board and gave them information regarding the Register of Deeds going to daily or weekly conversion of documents filed for recording through MIPS and will no longer copy filed documents into books. The current conversion fee is \$93.00 per month and the cost will change to \$168.00 per month for daily conversion or \$148.00 per month for weekly conversion depending on which service is contracted and the fee will be paid out of the Register of Deeds Preservation Fund.

Chris Rauner, Hwy Supt, met with the Board. Chris gave the rock report, discussed various roads, projects and equipment.
